Cambridge International Symposium on Economic Crime (CIDOEC), Jesus College, University of Cambridge, 1-8 September 2024 IUGS-IFG held a Plenary Workshop at the 41st International Symposium on Economic Crime on, 'Due Diligence of Gold; Challenges and Solution is the Global Supply Chain'. This was co-organised by Dr Laurance Donnelly (IUGS-IFG Chair) and Dr Shima Keene (former Head of OIC/IMS Threat Leadership Command, National Crime Agency, Director, Conflict Studies Research Centre and Special Advisor, Ministry of Defence, UK). IUGS-IFG was also supported by Prof Duncan Pirrie (IUGS-IFG Secretary), Mr Ricardo Cordeiro Vitoria de Moraes (IUGS-IFG Illegal Mining Adviser) and Dr Fábio Augusto Da Silva Salvador (IUGS-IFG Co-officer for Latin America). The workshop was also in collaboration with the Vice President and Federal Reserve Bank, New York and other consultants and collaborators from anti-money laundering, financial crime, bribery and sanctions compliance. The aim of the event was to draw attention to gold traceability, the Clean Gold Programme and opportunities for collaboration with the financial sector to mitigate illegal gold trading crimes.
